

Statement of the purpose of the Corporation

1. To engage in research on and to promote the study of the history and social aspects of the Polish community in Canada.
2. To co-ordinate the efforts aimed at the incorporation of values of Polish culture and of cultural achievements of the Polish community in Canada, in Canadian cultural life and development.
3. To hold conferences, lectures, meetings and exhibitions for the discussion of topics and the exchange of views in matters related to research activities.
4. To establish a library for the collection of books, periodicals and other publications and archival materials by Polish Canadian authors or relating to the Polish community in Canada.
5. To publish, finance and sell scholarly books, journals and studies dealing with the history and social aspects of the Polish community in Canada.
6. To enter into any arrangements with any authorities, public or academic or otherwise, which may seem conducive to the attainment of the objects of the corporation or any of them, and to obtain from any such authority any rights, privileges and concessions which the corporation may seem desirable to obtain and to carry out, exercise and comply with any such arrangements, rights, privileges and concessions.
7. To receive, acquire and hold gifts, donations, legacies, grants and bequest.
8. To purchase, acquire or take by gift, bequest or donation for the purpose of the furtherance of the objects of the corporation, and to sell, lease or otherwise dispose of, and subject to the provisions of section 65 of the *Canada Not-for-profit Corporations Act*, to mortgage any real or personal property.
9. To establish, construct or maintain suitable quarters for the corporation.
10. To do all such other things as are incidental and/or conducive to the attainment of the above objects.
